

Birmingham, Alabama. He asked what I was going to do in Birmingham and I told him that I had a trailer to set up.

4. During our conversation, I didn't notice anything unusual about Tommy. He acted like he always did, and he did not appear to be nervous or agitated.

5. The following day I heard about the murder of Troy Wicker, either by watching television or talking to someone. I never gave it any more thought until about two months later when I heard that Tommy Arthur had been arrested for murder. I began thinking about Tommy and the date of the murder. It was then that I recalled that I had spoken to Tommy the morning of the murder.

6. I did not tell anybody about my conversation with Tommy on the morning of February 1, 1982 with Mr. Arthur. I had never been approached by the police or Tommy's trial or appellate attorneys.
